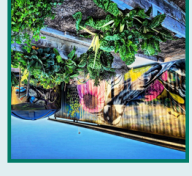
## MURALS IN DARGO

Sale-based artist Jeremy Kasper has played a significant role in bringing public spaces throughout the town to life with his vibrant murals. His work, which began on the walls of the former **Kurb Sk8** building (Raymond St), can now be seen across several key locations:

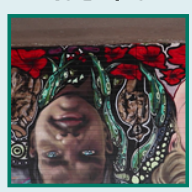
- **Hair New York** (Cunningham Street)
- **Sale RSL and Community Club** (York St), created with Robbie Farnham.
- **Seed Community Garden** (Montgomery St), a jointly with fellow artists Alan Solomon, Dawn and Chris Stubbs.
- **Sale Hospital**, where a piece celebrates the dedication of nurses. The previously plain walls of the Thomson River Overpass (South Gippsland Hwy) now feature three distinct pieces of art by Jeremy Kasper. These murals focus on the local wildlife that inhabits the area, showcasing: The Gippsland Water Dragon, the Brushtail Possum & the Azure Kingfisher.



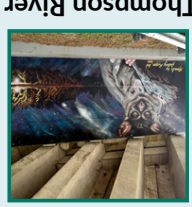

The clubhouse of the **Golden Beach Golf Club** on Surf Edge Drive features a beautifully vibrant piece of art by local artist Simon White.



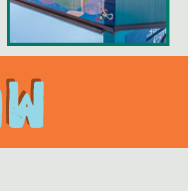

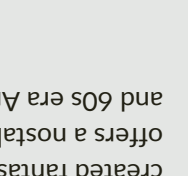

## MURALS IN MAFFRA

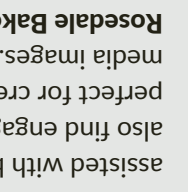

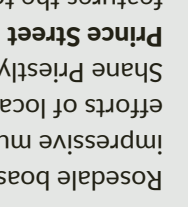

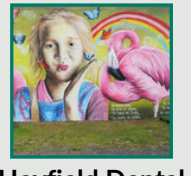
## STREET ART IN HEYFIELD

The timber town of Heyfield features a selection of vibrant street art murals, highlighting the talent of local artists:

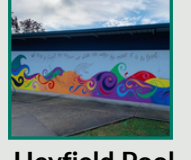
**Heyfield Pool (Cnr of Mary and Allman Sts)**: Artist Tams Hesz created a mural here as a gift to the Heyfield community.

## STREET ART IN STRATFORD

As you enter Stratford, you are greeted by several distinctive murals that reflect local history and culture:

**Bella the Elephant Mural** (Entrance from Sale): This piece commemorates Bella the circus elephant, who tragically died when a circus truck collided with the Stratford railroad underpass.

**New Rail Bridge Abutments**: As part of the Rail Projects Victoria, local artists Ray and Tirilli Thomas designed murals located on the abutments of the recently constructed rail bridge.

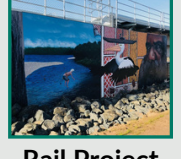
