There are 24 murals by Heesco in Yarram. The murals stretch from the Yarram Golf Club at one end of town, through many shop fronts and around the town itself. Start the trail at 42 Golf Links Rd (Yarram Golf Club), then head to Commercial Rd where most of the arts trail is located. Don't forget to swing by the Memorial Gardens and the Men's Shed and Yarram Tyres and Exhausts in Bland St for some more pieces.

In 2020, street artist Khosaran Khurelbaatar, known in the art world as Heesco was commissioned by the residents of Yarram to create a series of murals to increase visitors into the small town. This project has received both national and international media attention, and was awarded "Best Street Art Trail".
