Bairnsdale - Ideal base to explore the Gippsland Lakes, Mitchell River and surrounding forests.

Briagolong - is perhaps best known for the tranquil Blue Pool, a large natural pool in a gorge.

Dargo - is surrounded by forested hills, boulder-studded mountains and see-it-to-believe-it views.

Foster - is a mere 30 minutes from Wilsons Promontory and not far from other popular destinations.

Golden Beach - features golden sands, dunes, coastal vegetation and serene beauty of the 90 Mile Beach.

Heyfield - is a must stop town, with quality eateries and along with some amazing walks into the high country.

Lake Glenmaggie - is a mecca for all things water sports. Whether you want to just dip a toe in or take out the boat..

Lakes Entrance - is home to the end of the 90 Mile Beach and is part of the Gippsland Lakes system.

Licola - is a remote alpine town, and gateway to national parks and outdoor adventures.

Loch Sport - is located on the shores of Lake Victoria, the Gippsland Lakes and has access to the Ninety Mile Beach.

Maffra - is home to world class wineries, cafes and restaurants to sample. Along with fabulous attractions to visit.

Mt Hotham - is home to breathtaking views of the alpine peaks and has you covered with activities year round.

Omeo - is a pioneering mountain town is renowned for gold mining, high country cattle grazing and buildings.

Paynesville - is a charming village surrounded by lakes on three sides, with canals and inlets to explore.

Phillip Island - has beaches, family fun activities, little penguins and sleepy koalas in their own habitat.

Port Albert - with a deep history in fishing, whaling and much more, Port Albert is now a fisherman's paradise.

Rosedale - has a quirky metro feel, but still a quaint country charm with plenty of eateries and even a horse statue!

Seaspray - is set along the shores of the 90 Mile Beach, the town attracts beaching, fishing, boating types.

Stratford - is a tranquil town with an artsy vibe and provides a backdrop for swimming, fishing and canoeing.

Traralgon - is home to wide tree-lined streets, beautiful gardens and spacious parklands of Gippsland's largest city.

Walhalla - is set in a deep valley and surrounded by plunging hills, this picture-perfect town is worth the stop.

Wilson's Promontory - is Victoria's largest coastal wilderness area and is home to abundant wildlife.

Woodside Beach - is the ideal location for a peaceful yet brooding long walk. Take the short trail to the beach.

Yarram - is locked between the Tarra Bulga, Wilsons Promontory and the Ninety Mile Beach..
